News analysts, reporters, and producers create and broadcast news stories that inform the public. They research current issues, interview people in interest groups and organizations, and set up, and operate the equipment used to produce news programs, cable programs, and radio transmission engineering equipment.

Employment Outlook

Announcers hold about 1.5 million jobs. Currently, they hold approximately 1.5 million jobs and declining advertising revenue is slowing employment growth. Sound engineering technicians are projected to grow.


