Early Admissions Options

Regular Decision	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A set deadline to apply (example Dec.1, January 15)• Notified of decisions in March-April
Rolling Admissions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• You can apply whenever you want• Admission is granted on a first-come, first-serve basis, you can apply early for an early notification
Early <u>Action</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Non-binding• You can apply to multiple schools• Admission decision before winter break• Students usually have until May 1st to commit
Early <u>Decision</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Binding, agreement signed by Student, Parent, Counselor• You can only apply to <u>one</u> Early Decision school• Admission decision in December

Please turn in transcript & recommendation requests to the Counseling Office by the Deadline dates to ensure your counselor can meet College Due Dates.

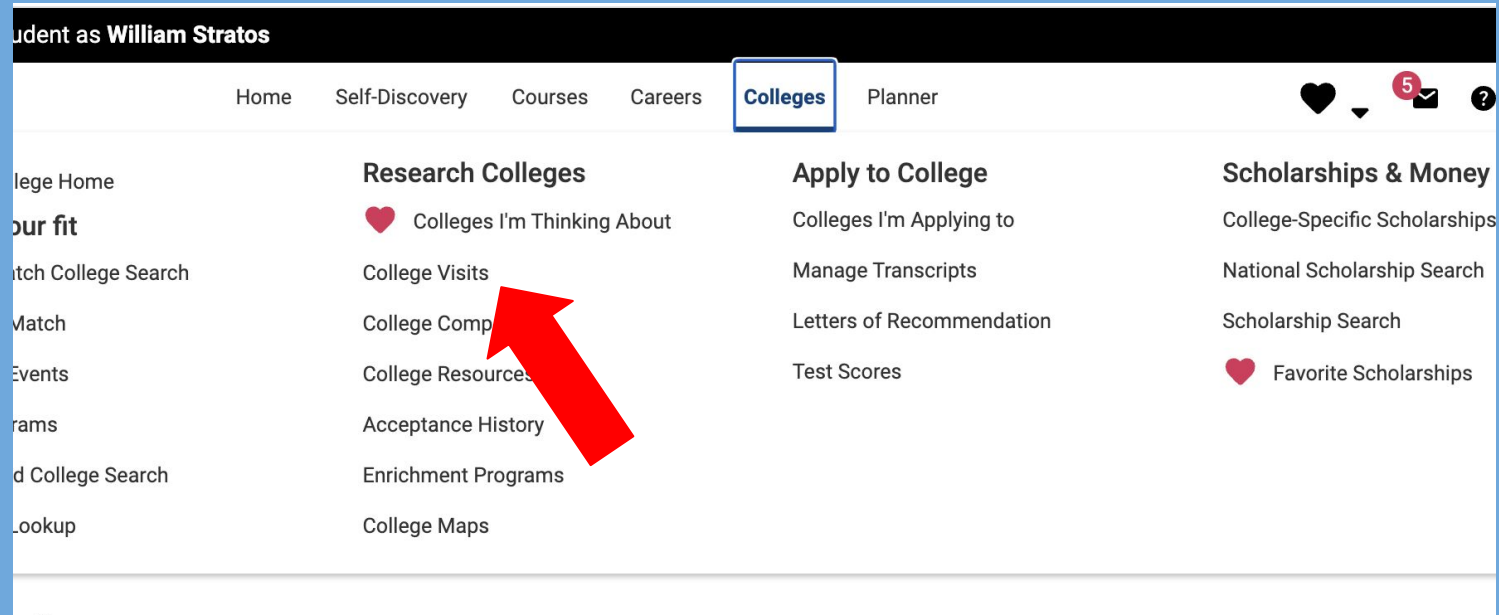

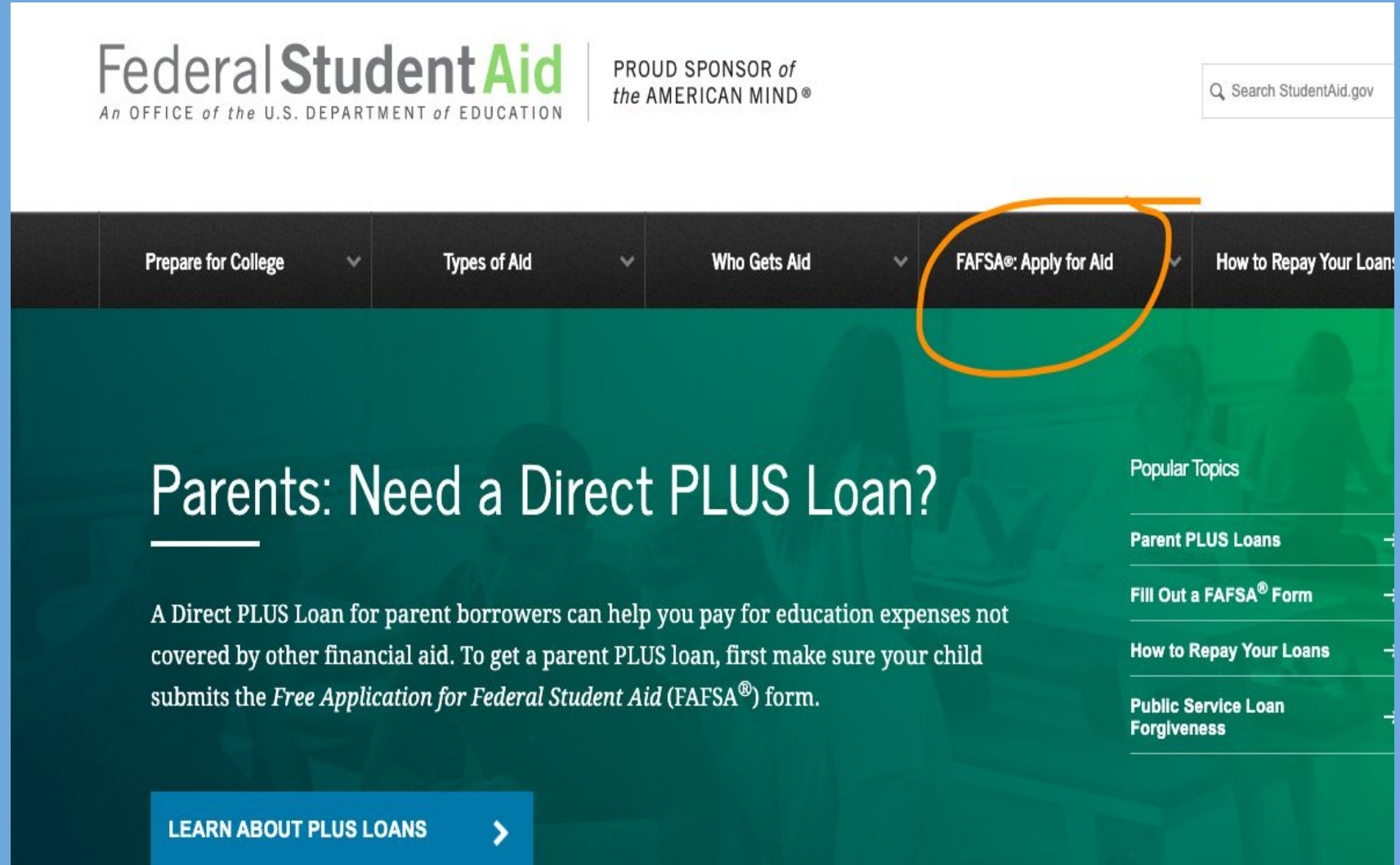
