School Profile 2024-2025

Yorktown Community Yorktown High School is located in Arlington, Virginia. Arlington County is home to one of the nation's most diverse and sophisticated student populations. Coming from countries around the world, Arlington students speak more than 104 different languages. They have ready access to a variety of cultural and academic resources in the county and in the nation's capital, which is located across the Potomac River. As a community of over 230,000 people, 75% of Arlington residents have a bachelor's degree or higher. This involved community actively supports Arlington Public Schools in cultivating inquiring minds, fostering social and emotional learning, and embracing equity with an appreciation of diverse cultures.

Curriculum Yorktown High School is one of three comprehensive high schools in Arlington County for students in grades 9 through 12. Yorktown offers a diverse curriculum that supports all learners, students with disabilities, students learning English, and gifted learners. Students may graduate with a Standard Diploma or an Advanced Studies Diploma. The curriculum also offers various levels of courses for students who choose to engage in challenging coursework, including the AP Capstone Diploma Program. Courses designated as Standard, and Principles indicate that the curriculum highlights a global approach to the subject with an emphasis on applications. Courses designated as Intensified or Advanced indicate the subject is studied in-depth and at an accelerated pace. Courses are offered for Dual Enrollment (DE), which allows students who successfully complete the course to receive both high school and college credit. Students enrolled in the Advanced Placement (AP) courses are required to take the accompanying AP test. Students who successfully complete a DE or AP class earn an extra quality point which is computed into their GPA. Students who successfully complete four AP courses in addition to the AP Seminar and AP Capstone and achieve a 3 or higher on the AP exams earn an AP Capstone Diploma.

ACTIVITIES AND ATHLETICS

All students are encouraged to participate in Yorktown's varied student clubs and activities, which include student government, academic clubs, classroom-based activities, social and service groups, visual and performing arts activities as well as sport and gaming clubs. Yorktown typically supports nearly 100 clubs/activities.

Yorktown is a member of the Virginia High School League (VHSL). Our student-athletes compete in 21 different sports and 5 VHSL activities: Theatre, Scholastic Bowl, Debate and Forensics, Robotics and eSports. Yorktown sports teams have earned many District, Region, and State championships, including Region championships during the 2023-24 school year for Field Hockey, Girls Swim/Dive and Girls Lacrosse. Recent state championships have been won in Girls Swim and Dive (2021, 2023 and 2024), Field Hockey (2021 and 2023), Girls Lacrosse (2022 and 2024), Girls Soccer (2022), Girls Crew (2021 and 2022) and Boys Lacrosse (2020).
