	Students are encouraged to take <b>at least one by the end of 11</b> <sup>th</sup> <b>grade</b> and again, if needed, in the summer or fall of their senior year.

	Continue to research your options (college, gap years, careers, vocational programs, etc)! Students are encouraged to explore prospective colleges with parents through visiting admissions websites, college visits, college fairs, using Naviance, and talking to current or former college students. Spring Break is a great time to explore all of your options.  Attend a Gap Year College Fair in the DMV for the other valuable experiences after high school
